**Structured Assessment for Analysing Learning (SAFAL)  
VI & IX**

Dear Parents,

**SAFAL: Structured Assessment for Analysing Learning (SAFAL)** is a competency-based diagnostic assessment as per the recommendation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 (para 4.40), launched by CBSE in its affiliated schools in July, 2021.

As a part of our continuous efforts to enhance the quality of education and foster competency-focused learning, SAFAL is being conducted in July and August 2024 for our students of classes VI and IX, who have completed classes V and VIII respectively in March 2024.

The primary purpose of SAFAL is to diagnose the areas where more efforts are required for quality teaching-learning at the school. Thus, SAFAL is a tool for assessment of the teaching-learning practices at schools and should be taken in this spirit only.

The following points should be noted:

- **Purpose and Nature of SAFAL:** SAFAL is a diagnostic assessment aimed at assessing the achievement of competencies by learners. This is neither a competition nor a qualifying/certification exam. Only the school-level competency reports will be given to all participating schools. Schools will be able to see only their own report without any comparison with any other school.
- **Preparation Requirement:** Preparation for SAFAL does not require any special measures. Our curriculum is already designed to focus on competencies and learner-centric teaching. Students are encouraged to approach SAFAL with their regular classroom learning. The exam will cover the syllabus from the last three years as well as the current session.
- **SAFAL Exam Schedule:** SAFAL at our school is scheduled from 22nd July to 12th August 2024. The students of classes VI and IX, who have completed classes V and VIII respectively in March 2024, will be participating.
  - The date sheet and schedule for SAFAL will be provided to the students by their respective class teachers.
  - It is imperative for all the students to be present on the designated exam days as retest/rescheduling of exam is not possible.
  - The exam will be conducted online within the school premises, and the students will be required to answer objective-type questions.
